PRINCIPAL'S LETTER

YEAR 12 RESULTS

Congratulations to the graduating class of 2012 who have achieved extraordinarily well in their final results. Congratulations to Parker Blakey who achieved the highest Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) in the College - and one of the highest in the ACT - with 99.10 out of a possible 99.95.

Out of 116 students who enrolled in a tertiary pattern of study (and were therefore eligible for an ATAR), 51 achieved a result of 80 or more - 19 of which achieved 90 or more! Again, this was an excellent result for MacKillop students.

Our calculations suggest that 98% of those who applied for university entrance will be successful, while 57% of them will gain a place at the Australian National University.

One of the very pleasing aspects of these results is that almost all students achieved between 5-12% beyond their expectations and are thus 'over the moon' with their achievement. Also pleasing is the fact that our median mark is up again for the fourth consecutive year.

This is a remarkable set of results for a school that proudly accepts all students of all abilities, which has a large inclusive education support program, that has among the lowest school fees in the territory, and a large number of students pursuing vocational education pathways. It is reassuring that our absolute commitment to be inclusive of all abilities has yielded splendid overall results and many, many students who have achieved well beyond their expectations!

On page 4 of today's Canberra Times is a detailed table showing the achievement of the Class of 2012 relative to the other 22 colleges in the ACT. Whilst not too much should be made of this table, the improving performance of Year 12 results at MacKillop continues to trend upwards and the MacKillop community can be proud that we are only behind Radford and Girls Grammar in terms of the number of our students achieving an ATAR of 65 or above.

Congratulations to the students and teachers who have developed such positive relationships that have been respectful, motivating, and successful. I really cannot praise the staff enough for all they have done for this group of students, or the work of Year 12 Coordinator Mr Jonathan Chandra who was present to all the needs of the class and who magnificently advocated on their behalf.

CONGRATULATIONS TO COLLEGE CAPTAIN TYLER FRIEND

Well done to Tyler who learned yesterday that he was one of 48 of 3000 applicants who were selected to train as pilots wit the RAAF through the Australian Defence Force Academy. Tyler was a splendid captain, won the Principal's Award at Graduation, achieved an ATAR of over 90 and now this - a remarkable year which reflects well on him, his family, and all the support he received from his school.
